**OPTIONS TO VISIT THE NEW MUSEUM OF AFRICAN AMERICAN
HISTORY & CULTURE**

Same-Day Online

Up to four (4) same-day timed entry passes are available online beginning at 6:30 a.m. daily until they run out. Same-day passes are **not available via phone**.

CHECK SAME-DAY AVAILABILITY

Walkups (Weekday Only)

A limited number of walk-up passes (one per person) are available starting at 1 p.m. on **weekdays** on the Madison Drive side of the building. **No walk up passes are available on Saturdays or Sundays** due to high visitation.

Security

For everyone's safety, all visitors are required to pass through screening at the entrance to the Museum. During the security process, you are greeted by one of our security personnel who conduct a thorough but speedy hand-check of all bags, briefcases, purses, strollers, and containers. All visitors are required to walk through a metal detector. Those visitors unable to go through the metal detector will be hand-screened with an electronic wand by security personnel. Please see THE list (below) of items not allowed in the Museum before planning your visit.

The following items are not permitted in the Museum at any time:

- tripods
- monopods
- selfie sticks
- guns
- 3D weapons
- knives
- pen knives
- pets
- food and drinks
- scissors
- aerosol cans, including pepper spray and Mace
- tools
- smoking
- placards, signs, or banners
